WARD FOUR ABSENTEE BALLOTS AVAILABLE

LEWISTON - The special municipal election to fill the vacancy in the position of City Councilor Ward Four will be held on Tuesday, February 7. Absentee ballots for this election are currently available for Lewiston residents from the City Clerk's Office. Registered voters needing an absentee ballot may call the City Clerk's Office, may mail in an application form which can be downloaded from the City's website, or can come into the City Clerk's Office, located on the second floor of City Hall to vote in person. Office hours are Monday - Friday, 8am - 4:30pm. The deadline to order absentee ballots is Thursday, February 2.

"Absentee voting is increasingly popular with each election" noted Lewiston City Clerk Kathy Montejo. "Voters are interested in absentee voting for a variety of reasons - they can have additional time to study and review their ballot, they can avoid going out in bad weather if it is rainy or cold on election day, and it is just more convenient for many voters." said Montejo.

There are three candidates seeking the Ward Four City Council seat:

Doreen Christ, 1 Buckley Street

Charles Turgeon, 43 Buckley Street
